A FUTURE INCLUDING EMPLOYMENT:

As a professional who supports individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities, it may be difficult for you to help families see a future for their young adult which includes employment. However, we know that people with all types of disabilities can, and do, work for real wages in the community.

Teachers, agency personnel, advocates, and other professionals who support students ages 13-26 years old with disabilities are encouraged to attend to learn how to establish partnerships with families that lead to improved employment opportunities for students.

- Establish a better understanding of the experience of families.
- Explore the impact of expectations and messaging on the decisions families make.

- Help families work through fears and apprehensions about competitive employment.
